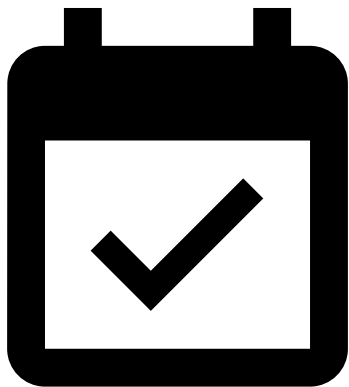


Let's Get Back to Business

The Keurig® K-Cup® Pod Deep Cleaning Kit is designed to service three single-serve coffee makers

NOTE: This kit is designed to service three single-serve coffee makers for one month, but it may also be used to service one single-serve coffee maker for three months



On a weekly basis, clean and sanitize your Keurig® single-serve coffee maker using **Urnex® Complete Café Sanitizer** and **Urnex® Rinza Liquid**

At least weekly, use **Urnex® Cleaning Cups** and spray exterior parts of your coffee maker with the prepared sanitizing solution

Included in your kit:

- Urnex® Complete Café Equipment Sanitizer
- Urnex® Rinza Liquid
- Urnex® K-Cup® Pod Brewer Cleaning Cups
- Empty Spray Bottle

You will also need a bucket for preparing each solution, as well as a lint-free, non-abrasive cloth

When cleaning...

- **Wash your hands** with soap and water for 20 seconds before and after cleaning
- **Wear disposable gloves** if they are available
- **Increase ventilation** by opening windows or adjusting air conditioning
- **Disinfect** high-touch surfaces regularly

Follow the instructions below to clean and sanitize your Keurig® Single-Serve Coffee Maker

First, **clean** your coffee maker to remove physical debris and coffee soil

Then, **sanitize** your coffee maker to kill viruses, germs, and bacteria

Cleaning Instructions

NOTE: If you choose to descale your coffee maker, please do so before following the cleaning instructions below

1. Remove K-Cup® pod holder, drip tray, water reservoir and waste basket (if applicable)
2. Prepare cleaning solution by adding **8 oz** (240 ml) of **Urnex® Rinza Liquid** to **1 gallon** (3.7 L) of **warm tap water** (or equivalent dilution)
3. Mix well and use immediately
4. Soak removed parts for 30 minutes in solution
5. Empty bucket and set aside parts to prepare sanitizing solution per the instructions to the right. If sanitizing procedure will not be performed, rinse well under clean running water and allow parts to drain and dry completely

NOTE: For non-removable parts, add cleaning solution to a soft cloth and use it to coat appliance parts. Then let sit for 30 minutes prior to wiping down with sanitizer solution. No need to rinse

Urnex® Cleaning Cups

Place the cleaning cup into the brewer and brew the largest cup size twice. Remove the cleaning cup from the brewer and brew twice on 10 oz without a Cleaning Cup or pod to rinse

Sanitizing Instructions

NOTE: Parts must be cleaned prior to sanitizing

1. Prepare sanitizing solution by adding **0.5 oz** (15 ml) of **Urnex® Complete Café Equipment Sanitizer** to **1 gallon** (3.7 L) of **warm tap water** (or equivalent dilution)
2. Mix well and use immediately
3. Soak removed parts for 1 minute in solution
4. Remove parts from solution and allow to drain and dry completely. Do NOT rinse or apply water

Create a Sanitizing Spray:

For non-removable brewer parts and to use on all parts in between sanitizing soaks

1. Prepare sanitizing solution by adding **4 ml** of **Urnex® Complete Café Equipment Sanitizer** to **1 L** of **warm tap water** (or equivalent dilution) in a spray bottle
2. Spray exterior surface of appliance and allow solution to remain on surface for 1 minute
3. Wipe away with clean cloth and allow to fully air dry

NOTE: This spray can be used to help remove contaminants on the K-Cup® pod holder, pivot, and removable water reservoir (if applicable) in between uses

NOTE: The cleaning instructions found on each product are a **general recommendation** from the manufacturer. The instructions above should be used for Keurig® coffee makers
