Using the zero-water dyeing process of our Color Pulse fiber technology, Wild Dyer carpet tile creates organic warmth with pools of neutrals and glimpses of brights, while delivering a lower environmental impact that saves up to one cup of water per carpet tile.

Used together or separately, Curious Cluster and Wandering Troop create dynamic depths of movement with a beautifully constructed palette.





Colorways





Using those four neutrals as a base, we transform them into four additional colorways through the incorporation of our shortwave Color Pulse fiber. This expands the palette by adding subtle glances of brighter hues, drawing inspiration from the warm, inviting colors of lobster mushroom dye.



Laria Saunders



To explore the inspiration behind Wild Dyer, we commissioned a work from Laria Saunders. Laria creates digital photo assemblage paintings, each one a combination of digital paint work and 50-100 photographs of textures encountered in her daily life. She is an artist on the ArtLifting platform, which champions artists impacted by disabilities or housing insecurities.

Having suffered debilitating pain for more than two decades, Laria was recently able to start managing her pain through natural medicines. As she shared in discussing this new piece, “My main inspiration is the healing effects that plants and fungi have had on my health.”

In *Ciclo de Las Setas*, Laria interprets key aspects of mushroom growth—from their underground mycelium to the fruiting bodies we recognize. She explains, “To me, the most fascinating aspect of the mushroom is the mycelium ... a vast network between all plant life, enabling a form of communication and a sharing of resources. Perhaps, this network is what makes the healing aspects of mushrooms so powerful.”





Mohawk's floor preparation procedures must be followed to ensure that the substrate has been prepared properly. Failure to use Mohawk Group adhesives or to follow Mohawk's floor preparation procedures will void all lifetime adhesive warranties. Please contact your local Sales Representative for installation guidelines.

These patterns contain inherent characteristics which may result in pattern run off and/or pattern appearance variations at the seams or tile edges (darker or lighter pattern lines). These characteristics are inherent in the patterns and are not manufacturing defects. Consideration to these characteristics should be given when selecting an installation method.

Chair pads are recommended under office chairs with roller casters to preserve appearance retention, act as a deterrent toward delamination and to prevent premature or accelerated wear. Walk-off tiles from the Tuft Stuff II Collection are recommended at entryways to reduce soiling.
