



DECKING & RAILING PLANNING GUIDE











Rectangle Deck

- » Standard shape makes for a versatile, multi-use space




Overlook Deck

- » Easily divided into separate spaces for lounging, dining, grilling and more





Your railing is just the start of your head-to-toe decking look. See how we coordinated, contrasted and changed up the railing for one of our favorite Transcend tropical decking colors, Tiki Torch, and all the chic styling that followed.

Here a cocktail rail perfectly matches the deck board and balusters pick up the dark streaks in the wood grain. It all comes together for a classic, timeless yet modern look where every piece complements the other.

Here the railing moves in the opposite direction of the decking—Classic White looks crisp against the deep brown. Alternately, if you choose a light decking board, you can achieve a contrasted look by selecting a darker color railing.

Here's where things get really daring. Dark aluminum railing and balusters complement the deck boards while contrasting with the Classic White post, creating a look that is a mixture of textures and colors—truly curated variety.









